



Remembering Izzy Cartoon Contest

Purpose of contest:

- To commemorate the life and work of Greenbelt cartoonist Izzy Parker on the 10th anniversary of his death.
- To recognize and encourage cartoonists of all ages by giving their work exposure in the Greenbelt News Review and other venues in Greenbelt.

Contest deadline: September 26, 2014

The postmark date or e-mail date will be taken as the official delivery date of entry.

Eligibility: Contest is open to everyone

Categories: *Children (ages 5-12); *Teens (ages 13-17); Adults (ages 18+)

*Parent permission is required for all competitors under age 18

Submission limit: Each participant may submit a maximum of three entries.

Requirements:

- Submitted artwork must be participant's original creation.
- Drawings must be one panel in black and white; hard copy on paper no larger than 8.5 x11;
- Electronic copy of black and white cartoon as grayscale at a minimum 300 dpi resolution in either a jpeg, png or pdf format.
- Participant's name, address, phone number and e-mail address must be on back of each submitted cartoon.
- All entries to be sent electronically and hard copy mailed.

I agree that the GNR, the GM or their agents shall not be responsible for any allegations of copyright infringement with respect to the publication of my submitted artwork and that I will be legally and financially responsible to reimburse the GNR, the GM and/ or their agents for any losses resulting from any such allegation and/or litigation.
